

Freedom Act

- SR175 an hour minimum wage (including gig work)
- SR24,500 a month UBI per person under a SR294,000 yearly income
- UBI based on the previous or project 12 months
- UBI for under age 16 paid to legal guardians
- UBI to be non-refundable and non-taxable
- 20% consolidated flat tax over SR84,000 a year (with double taxation)
- 20% corporate tax on profits
- 20% value added tax on each stage of sale (paid quarterly)
- 20% value added tax on imports
- VAT registration over SR84,000 a year
- Sole trader registration over SR84,000 a year
- Capital gains to be tax liable
- Gambling winnings to be tax free
- Foreign passive income to remain tax free
- Voter eligibility lowered to age 16
- Member of the National Assembly lowered to age 16
- Non-binary gender passports
- Gender-affirming surgery legalised at age 16
- Transgender self-identification legalised at age 16 (parental consent under age 16)
- Gay and polygamy marriage legalised
- Age of marriage and gambling lowered to age 16
- Sale of alcohol, tobacco and vapes lowered to age 16
- Recreational drugs decriminalised
- Light motorcycle licence raised to age 18
- Primary and secondary schools to become optional
- 4-year fixed term presidential elections beginning in 2036
- Presidential and National Assembly elections to be merged
- The National Assembly reduces its membership to directly elected seats only
- National Assembly elections to be decided by the popular vote and first-past-the-post voting
- National Assembly coalition greater than 50% votes overrides the highest overall party percentage
- Initiate the African Union flag to be a green version of the European flag
- Initiate the creation of an African Union Customs Union and African Parliament elections in 2036
- Seychellois born lifetime citizenship and dual citizenship legalized

Estimated Revenue: SR18 billion a year (SR1 billion a year surplus)
